In the days of Elijah, God's prophet confronted deception and false religion in a dramatic showdown on Mount Carmel with the false prophets of Baal. The altar of the Lord was broken down and the people had turned away from the God of Israel. Elijah restored the altar of the Lord with twelve stones according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob (1Kings 18:30-31), and cried out to the Lord to meet His people. Then God manifested His presence as holy fire fell from heaven. All the people fell on their faces and cried, The Lord, He is God! The Lord, he is God! (v.39). Once again God is confronting the powers of darkness and hearing the prayers of His body on Mount Carmel.

The altar on Carmel continues to be a place of encounter, sacrifice, praise and proclamation. We invite you to join us on top of Mount Carmel for our 5th annual convocation which will include in-depth teaching on the

prophetic significance of Israel, the Church, and Islam. There will also be an emphasis on intercessory worship sessions as we join together with one another as the one new man of Jews, Arabs, and Gentiles from the nations, being built together as a dwelling place for God in the Spirit (Ephesians 2:22). We are believing for life-changing encounters with the with the Lord God of Israel during our days together and that He will answer our corporate prayers on behalf of the people of our Land.

Please pray about participating in this strategically-timed gathering and consider bringing a group from your congregation. A five-day biblical tour will also be available following the convocation.

CONVOCATION COST AND PAYMENT:

US\$ 650 per person (double occupancy) includes:

5 nights from Tuesday, May 8 until Sunday, May 13 half-board (breakfast and dinner) accommodation at the Dan Panorama Hotel in the center of Haifa. Transportation provided to and from the hotel to the worship center at Kehilat HaCarmel.

NOT INCLUDED: Airfare to and from Israel, transfer to and from airport, medical insurance and personal expenses, any visa applications if required.

REGISTRATION: Apply to: convocation@carmel-assembly.org.il for a registration form or information about a group coordinator in your area. Only fully completed registration forms with deposits will be accepted.

CANCELLATION: All cancellations prior to April 2 will be refunded except for US\$ 200 non-refundable fee. Cancellation on or after April 2 will be subject to a cancellation fee of US\$200 per person (i.e. \$400).

CONVOCATION cash registration fee: · US\$ 120 (or equivalent in €) includes lunches and tips during the Convocation

· US\$10 (or equivalent in €) for translation headset if required

PAYMENTS:

1. Deposit of US\$ 200 by February 24, 2012 (nonrefundable)
2. Final payment US\$ 450 by April 02, 2012
3. US\$ 120 (or equivalent in €) in cash at REGISTRATION upon arrival.
4. US\$10 (or equivalent in €) in cash at REGISTRATION upon arrival for TRANSLATION HEADSET if required

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT: Add US\$ 375 if you require a single room. The number of single rooms is limited.

If you need to cancel and are sharing a room, you will be responsible to cover the cost of the single supplement.

SCHEDULE :

1. Check-in on the afternoon of Tuesday, May 8, followed by dinner and a brief introductory meeting.
2. Teaching and worship sessions on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. All day from Wednesday till Thursday night. Friday sessions end mid- afternoon followed by dinner to usher in the Shabbat.
3. Thursday night: Intercessory worship evening with Kehilat HaCarmel, led by Karen Davis.
4. Saturday: Join the Shabbat service with Kehilat HaCarmel. Enjoy traditional lunch in the Druze village. Visit Muqraka, overlooking the Valley of Armageddon, with on-site teaching. Pray over the city of Haifa from the Louis Promenade.
5. Sunday, May 13: the package for the Convocation ends after breakfast.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE:

Sunday, May 13: Tour of the Galilee including Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, a boat trip on the Sea of Galilee

Monday, May 14: Tour of ancient Caesarea, a teaching session in the Roman Amphitheater; go up to Jerusalem; have lunch near Jerusalem; visit Israel Museum

Tuesday, May 15: Visit Temple Mount; the Western Wall, teaching on the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount; Old City; visit Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial

Wednesday, May 16: Visit Masada, Herod's desert fortress; Qumran, the caves of the Dead Sea Scrolls; have lunch at Qumran, and swim in the Dead Sea

Thursday, May 17: Teaching on the Mt. of Olives; prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane; Bethesda Pool at St. Anne's Church; Garden Tomb visit

Friday, May 18: Check-out and depart for Ben Gurion International Airport

TOUR COST AND PAYMENT:

US\$ 800 per person (double occupancy) which includes:

- 5 nights half-board accommodation (breakfast and dinner) in the Dan Panorama Hotel in Haifa (1 night) and Crowne Plaza Hotel in Jerusalem (4 nights).
- 3 Lunches - alongside the Sea of Galilee, upon arrival in Jerusalem and at the Dead Sea.
- 5 full days touring assisted by our own teaching staff and believing guides.

PAYMENTS:

2. Final payment by April 2, 2012.
